## QUEEN'S COMMONWEALTH ESSAY

The Queen's Commonwealth Essay Competition is the world's oldest schools' international writing competition, managed by The Royal Commonwealth Society since 1883. Every year, it offers all Commonwealth youth aged 18 and under the opportunity to express their hopes for the future, opinions of the present, and thoughts on the past. In 2019, 11,000 young people from across the Commonwealth entered the Competition. This year's competition, on the theme 'A Connected Commonwealth' asked entrants to consider how they can work to use cultural, technological and environmental connections for positive change across the Commonwealth. CGS / CGSD had a total of 56 winners. These included 34 Bronze, 15 Silver and 7 Gold winners. Pictured above are winners from CGSD.
