67 CGS students achieved the Gold Award - more than any other institution in the country! Some of the winners pictured above at the recent ceremony at the British High Commissioner's residence.



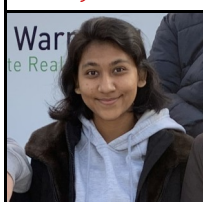
RS CONFERENCE AT CGS
