The academic year 2019 / 2020 is packed with activities and events, including a Science and IT Fair, ACP's, a staff Convention the CGS conference, a Singapore study tour as well as all the usual events and mufti days. Our theme for the year, '**Fearless Future Forward**' will address the challenges this generation faces to combat the big questions of our time. The CGS Round Square conference for 2020 will be based on the pillars of leadership and adventure and will include a trek at the CGS Forest Retreat in Mati Ta near Bhatiyari. Climate change, plastics in oceans, extreme poverty, conflicts and artificial intelligence are some of the conversations that we will have at our annual conference and indeed over the year.

We have over three dozen RS and MUN invitations from across the globe to attend conferences in several cities in India, and in the United Kingdom, as well as in Jordan, Chile, Laos, Morocco, South Korea, Singapore, Switzerland, Romania, and Madagascar! We will select the most interesting and enriching experiences. A 21 member team has already signed up to attend the Round Square International Conference in October at Emerald Heights School in Indore, India. Our RS and MUN opportunities are expanding each year to new destinations and we are hoping to equal the last two year's record of 20 conferences in each year! Conferences and travel are an integral part of the CGS experience and we urge parents to enrol their children for these experiences. One such special opportunity this year, aligned with our theme is a 5 day study tour to Singapore which will highlight the challenges of urbanisation and will include workshops, classroom discussions, guided tours, driven by facilitators and experts in the field. All students will be invited to enrol for this in class groups.

We started the year with a series of workshops on 'Positive Discipline' and the counselling component in a teacher's role. Increasingly mental health is becoming a concern and students need counsellors they can turn to at school for academic or non-academic issues. We have therefore increased the number of counsellors at each campus and their offices are always open for walk-in chat opportunities for students. Parents are also invited to talk to the school counsellors and develop a closer bond between school and home, thereby ensuring we create the best atmosphere for your child to flourish.

Our focus on values and moral well-being is moving up a notch with the introduction of a programme targeting 18 values we have identified for the academic year, 2019 / 2020, as follows.


'O' LEVEL RESULTS 2019: CLASS 9

168 Students in CGS and CGSD appeared for 399 'O' Levels, for between 2 and 3 subjects each. They did very well in their first set of 'O' levels. They opened their accounts for collecting A* and A grades, achieving 85% for A*, A and B grades, up from last year's 81%.



'O' LEVEL RESULTS 2019: CLASS 10

122 students appeared for 1045 'O' Levels in 2019. Combined CGS and CGSD results had an overall pass rate of 98% and an A*, A and B ratio of 78%. 52% or 64 out of 122 candidates attained 5A's or more in 'O' levels.
